An Advent wreath with Advent candles is a tradition that helps Christians focus attention on the coming of the Christ at Bethlehem and at the close of history. As Advent is the beginning of the liturgical year, this season also begins the retelling of the biblical stories of the life of Jesus on earth in physical form. This next year, scripture selections upon which worship will focus, will be chosen most often from the Gospel of Luke.

Here in the Northern hemisphere, this time of year is the darkest. Jesus is the Light of the World and thus brings God's hope. You may find that being in worship each Sunday and on Christmas Eve, brightens your celebration of Christmas - the coming of Jesus into the world.


