

The Liturgist reads the scriptures during worship. We will provide the reader with the scriptures




via email or USPS mail several days prior to the service allowing you time to become comfortable in reading to the congregation.

This is a very worthwhile program, so consider donating generously. Please make checks payable to St. Philip's and note One Great Hour on the memo line. Thank you!


#### **NEW PHONE DIRECTORIES**
