

"Happy Birthday to You!, Happy Birthday to You!, Happy Birthday Everybody!, and God Bless you!"





Also, we no longer recycle plastic lids. Please don't bring them to church but do continue to recycle them appropriately. All the little things, done by a lot of people, do make a difference!


YOUNG(ER) ADULT FELLOWSHIP

BOOK CLUB NEWS


Sunday June 26 10:15am

GRADUATE RECOGNITION SUNDAY, JUNE 12


