**St. John UCC** will have an **Ash Wednesday Service at 10:00am**, including holy communion and the imposition of ashes.

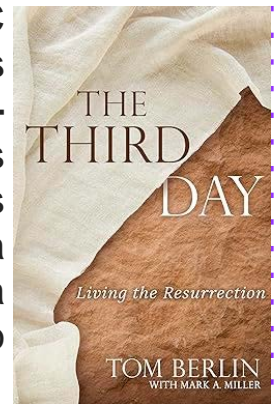

## ST. PHILIP'S OUTREACH MINISTRY



Our Lenten project will benefit the food pantry at Isaiah 58 Ministries, on South Grand Boulevard, which provides food for needy residents in the South City and the South County area. While any shelf stable food and canned items are accepted, there is a special need for the following items: Beef Stew, Canned greens, coffee, hot chocolate, toilet paper, laundry detergent, oatmeal, canned fruit, salt-free seasoning (Mrs. Dash), bar soap, deodorant, Multipurpose cleaner, sardines, hearty soup, cooking oil (48 ounces or smaller), shampoo, razors, shaving cream, dish soap, peanut butter (smooth) deluxe Mac and Cheese, shelf-stable milk, toilet paper, and paper towels. They also need season appropriate clothing and shoes for all ages (They have limited storage space, so please donate spring or summer clothing). Items will be collected during lent, starting on Sunday, February 18. Thank you in advance!

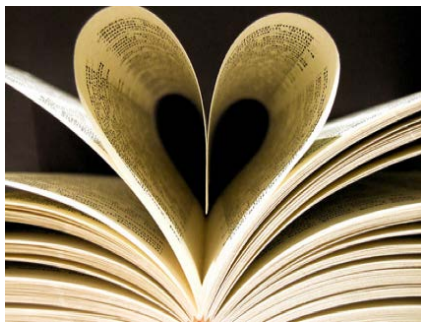

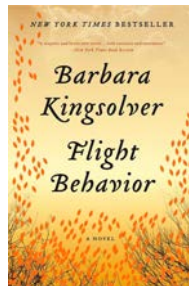
## St. John UCC's February Special Offering

## BOOK CLUB



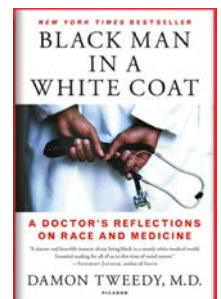

## Road Trip!

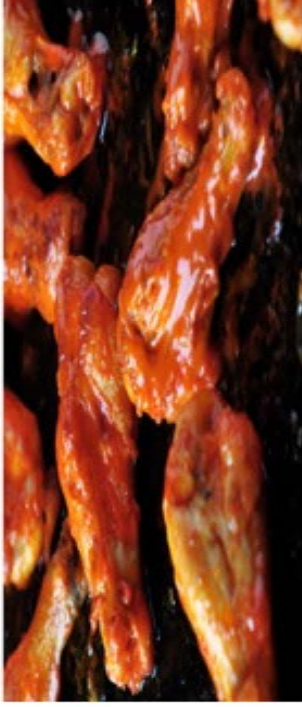
